We have 10-12 organized fishing trips (fishalongs) per year, typically within a couple of hours drive of the Portland Metro area. We usually have at least one multi-day trip per year. Many of our members have caught their first fish on a fly at one of our outings. Members help each other with fishing techniques, fly selection, reading the water, and finding new spots to fish. Some of the places we've visited include the Deschutes, Metolius, McKenzie, lower Umpqua, Clackamas Owyhy and Donner und Blitzen rivers, and Lost, Merrill, East and Hosmer Lakes.
